Guided walks around the site of the Limeworks which started on Llanymynech Hill in the mid-1700s and eventually closed in 1914. See one of only 3 Hoffmann kilns left in the country (the only one still with its chimney).



Sunday, 13 September 12 – 4.30

As well as guided walks there will also be demonstrations of lime burning and lime slaking, vintage films with locally-composed music in the Hoffmann kiln and canal-inspired interactive art with artist Mair Hughes.
